## Veteran-led Team Rubicon Supporting Flood Clean-Up Efforts in Gibson City, IL

GIBSON CITY, IL (August 15, 2021) – <u>Team Rubicon</u>, a veteran-led disaster response organization, is providing support to Gibson City for flooding that occurred as a result of heavy rain on August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Severe thunderstorms dumped nine inches of rain in parts of southern Ford County, IL including Gibson City. This heavy rain event resulted in significant flooding making most roads in the area impassable. Numerous homes and businesses were flooded to the point that water rescues were necessary for several citizens.

A Team Rubicon Task Force will assist with damage assessment and flood clean-up in Gibson City and the surrounding area starting on August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The Task Force will be led by Jarrett Brown who will coordinate with state, county, and local authorities. The response is expected to last until the 30<sup>th</sup> of August. 30 Team Rubicon volunteers will be operating out of the Gibson City Fire Department.

Team Rubicon serves communities by mobilizing veterans to continue their service by leveraging their skills and experience to help people prepare, respond, and recover from disasters and humanitarian crises.
