## **Ford County Public Health Department Offering School Immunizations**

Ford County – Public school vaccinations are required for Kindergarten, Sixth Grade, and High School students between the ages of 16-18 years of age.

## Available vaccinations include:

- Diptheria/Tetanus/Acellular Pertussis (DTaP)
   Tetanus/Diptheria/Acellular Pertussis (TDaP)

  Protection against Tetanus, Diptheria and Pertussis
- Inactivated Poliovirus (IPV) Protections against Polio
- Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) Protection against Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- Varicella (Chickenpox) Protection against Chickenpox disease
- Meningococcal (Meningitis) Protection against Meningitis infection
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)\* Protection against HPV Virus as well as related cancers including cervical cancer (\*recommended vaccine)
- Hepatitis A\* Protection against Hepatitis A Virus (\*recommended vaccine)
- Moderna Protection against Covid 19

Kindergarten vaccines include: Diptheria/Tetanus/Acellular Pertussis (DTaP), Inactivated Poliovirus (IPV), Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR), Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccines.

6<sup>th</sup> Grade vaccines include: Tetanus/Diptheria/Acellular Pertussis (TDaP), Meningococcal (Meningitis) and beginning series of Human Papillomavirus (HPV) is recommended.

High School students aged 16-18 include: Meningococcal (Meningitis), and Human Papillomavirus (HPV) is recommended.

Vaccine clinic dates will be: July 15, 2024 from 9am-12pm and 2pm-4pm and July 25, 2024 from 1pm-4pm.
